

AGREEMENT BETWEEN CARP AND CURAC, 2009

CARP MEMBERSHIP BENEFIT: CARP will provide the following savings for members of CURAC/ARUCC Member Associations (hereinafter referred to as "CURAC members"). The offer applies to members who are not yet members of CARP and to existing CARP members, who wish to renew.

CURAC members will enjoy a 25% discount on the combined membership and magazine package. We are prepared to maintain that 25% discount on the initial enrollment after the price increase (April 1). Please note that if a CURAC member who is a current CARP member wants to renew his or her CARP membership for one, or for three years, we will honour the discounted rate. There are substantial savings if your members enroll at the special CURAC rate for three years. That is a 57% saving. (*** Note: Although the price of membership and Zoomer Magazine will increase 1 April 2009, CARP will honour the special \$14.95 annual rate and \$44.85 three year rate for CURAC members until 31 May 2009, to allow CURAC members to be informed of the offer through newsletter, websites, etc. Thereafter, the 25% discount will apply against the new 1 April rate for membership and magazine.**)

This discount for CURAC members will take place immediately upon acceptance of this agreement.

MUTUAL PROMOTION ON WEBSITE:

CURAC and CARP will cross-promote our respective organizations on our websites and other communications vehicles. For example, CARP would expect CURAC to promote the special membership fee for CURAC members on the CURAC website and in your newsletters during the year. CARP will reciprocate on its website.

ADVOCACY PROCESS & CONSULTATION:

Subject to establishing a process for doing so, CURAC and CARP will provide the opportunity to consult on advocacy issues of common interest, such as pension and retirement issues, to our members with a view to establishing mutually supportive briefs and submissions to government wherever possible. Susan Eng heads the advocacy portfolio. Check our website for details of this activity.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS: CARP and CURAC will consult further on the most appropriate protocol or framework for developing formal and/or informal ties on matters of mutual interest.
